Landmarks und activities from the west of Hamburg to the city:

- Bike tour alongside the river Elbe from city Wedel (west Neighborhood of Hamburg) passing small sailing harbor and forests with beautiful views to the fish market in Altona close to the port of Hamburger up to concert hall Elbphilharmonie. Total distance is approx. 20 km.
- „Willkomm Höft“ in Wedel, where all ships approaching Hamburg are received with their national anthem.

- The “Elbhöhenweg” – a hiking track for fans of nature with beautiful views between the romans garden (Italian atmosphere in Hamburg) and the museum of dolls at the Falkenstein banks.
- “Treppenviertel” in Blankenese – a quarter with stairs and small lanes, nice houses going down to river Elbe.
- HADAG ferry from Blankenese to town of Cranz located in the so called „Altes Land“ famous as Europe largest cultivation area for apple.
- Loki Schmidt Garden, botanic garden from the former first lady of Germany’s canceler Helmut Schmidt, to be reached by local train to S-Bahn station Klein Flottbek
- Jenisch Park - 1 Park with 3 museums: Jenisch Haus, Ernst-Barlach-Haus, Bargheer Museum
- HADAG ferry on river Elbe from Teufelsbrück to the Landungsbrücken and Elbphilharmonie
- „Övelgönne“ with the harbor museum of historic ships and boats
- “Alter Elbtunnel” - old tunnel crossing the river Elbe (walking or by bike) from the city to Blohm&Voss shipyard
- Fishmarket und „Fischauktionshalle“ – former auction hall for fish
- St. Pauli with Reeperbahn – Theaters, Nightclubs, Bars and Entertainment
- Capital church St. Michaelis („Michel”)
- Harbour- and warehouse district, harbour city and Elbphilharmonie
- „Miniatur Wunderland“ – World largest model railway; [Dialogue in the Dark](#)
- City Hall
- „Kunstmeile“ – various museums and exhibitions for art: Kunsthalle, Museum für Kunst und Gewerbe, Deichtorhallen, Kunstverein, Bucerius Kunstforum (€ 36,00)
